## MARINE BOARD TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING ON NEW BOAT FEE RULES

The Oregon State Marine Board will hold a public meeting on proposed rules implementing House Bill 2220, the Aquatic Invasive Species Prevention program. The meeting will be held at the Marine Board office, 435 Commercial Street NE, on Tuesday, September 22 at 5:30 p.m. in Salem.

After public input is received, Marine Board staff will summarize comments and present the Board with proposed rule language at the next Board meeting, scheduled for

October 13 at the Riverhouse in Bend.

Additionally, the Marine Board seeks written comments on the proposed Aquatic Invasive Species Prevention program rules beginning September 1 through September 30. Written comments may be submitted by mail to June LeTarte, OSMB, PO Box 14145, Salem, OR 97309; by email to osmb.rulemaking@state.or.us; or by fax to (503) 378-4597. Written comments may also be handed in at the public meeting.

All comments must be received or postmarked by September 30. Telephone comments will not be accepted.

## SNOWY PLOVER NESTING SEASON ENDED SEPTEMBER 16

### Access Restrictions at Area Beaches Lifted

Coos Bay, ORE. – The nesting season for the western snowy plover ended September 16 and access restrictions put into place last spring have been lifted, granting visitors access to the dry sand portions of area beaches.

Dry and closures will be lifted for habitat sites at Sutton Beach, Siltcoos Estuary, Oregon Dunes Day Use, Tahkenitch Estuary, Tenmile Estuary (northern Coos County), the North Spit of Coos Bay, Bandon Beach State Natural Area, and New River area beaches. The access restrictions affected 18 miles of beach in Oregon.

Even though the official nesting season is over, biologists caution plovers are still active and ask people to pay attention when they are on the beach. "There are still several plovers out and about on the beaches, raising their family. The weather has been warm lately, and the plovers may have nested later this year because of summer's later arrival," said Kerrie Palermo,

Wildlife Biologist with the Bureau of Land Management.

Population numbers for this summer are still being tabulated, and the results of this year's nesting season will be available later this fall.
